Hard Reset or Factory Reset is the process to restore software and system settings to factory defaults. This operation deletes all data, settings, passwords, apps and clears storage. It is recommended to backup data before proceeding to Hard Reset Oppo A5 2020. Oppo A5 2020 Factory Reset or Hard Reset is commonly used to repair a damaged or malfunctioning device, bypass or remove screen lock pattern/PIN/passcode on the device, fix software-related issues, software lag, or sluggishness, etc. It can also be used when selling the phone or tablet to wipe all the personal data and system settings. On the other hand, Oppo A5 2020 Soft Reset is commonly known as a reboot or restart. This operation doesn't involve any loss of data and settings. It is usually carried out to fix device slowness or slow operation, software errors, memory errors, operating system errors, app errors, etc. Soft Reset clears RAM and temporary cache and gives your device a quick boost. Sometimes, the data stored in RAM and temporary cache gets corrupted; this results in App errors, OS errors, phone freeze, and other software-related issues. Thus, performing a Soft Reset solves most of the software problems with the phone. Also: Oppo Reno 5 Lite Factory Hard Reset How to Hard Reset or Factory Reset Oppo A5 2020 Below are the methods that can help you factory reset or hard reset Oppo A5 2020. Factory Reset Oppo A5 2020 from Settings Open Settings on your phone. Scroll down and tap on Backup & Reset. Look for the Factory data reset option and tap on it. Now, tap on the RESET PHONE button and enter your Passcode or PIN. Now, select ERASE EVERYTHING to erase all your data, apps, and settings. Oppo A5 2020 Hard Reset from Recovery Mode Power off your phone. Now, boot Oppo A5 2020 into Recovery Mode. When the device boots into Recovery, highlight the wipe data/factory reset option using Volume keys and select it using the Power button. Now, select the Yes - delete all user data option and press the Power button to perform the operation. Now, all your data, apps, and settings will be deleted. When done, select the reboot system now option to reboot your device. Now, your Oppo A5 2020 is Hard Reset and restored to factory defaults. Note: After Oppo A5 2020 Hard Reset, you may be required to enter the previously used Google Account details when setting up the device. It is a security feature added by Google starting from Android 5.0 Lollipop, and this feature is called Factory Reset Protection (FRP). How to Soft Reset Oppo A5 2020 To perform Soft Reset operation smoothly, press and hold the power button, select the Restart or Power OFF option, wait for 20-30 seconds, and power the device back ON. For Smartphones with removable batteries, Soft Reset can be performed by removing the battery and inserting it back again after a few seconds. In the case of a non-removable battery, when the device freezes, you can try to use a combination of keys along with the power button to power OFF your device. We can do it with 2 ways by pressing combinations of external hardware keys (hard reset) and from Settings menu (soft reset). If you perform a hard reset, make sure to back up important data. The data can not be recovered after perform a hard reset. If your Oppo A5 has such a problem e.g slowing down and generates error messages, you can use the reset option straight from inside the Android operating system. So no need to panic, because you can use the reset option through both your smartphone settings and the recovery mode. The Oppo A5 comes with an Octa-Core processor that has a clock speed of 1.8 GHz. It acts as the brain of the system and takes care of the overall performance. The Oppo A5 houses a 64GB inbuilt storage, which can be expanded up to 256GB by using a memory card. The processor is further aided by a 4GB ram. Oppo A5 sports a 6.2-inch IPS LCD display that has a screen resolution of 720 x 1520 pixels. It comes with a great pixel density of 271 PPI that provides quite a good viewing experience. On the optical front, there is an 8MP primary lens that can click mesmerizing images with a screen flash. 3 Methods to Reset Oppo A5 When the Oppo A5 misbehaves or when you encounter a bug, your first thing is usually to factory reset your phone. This nifty trick takes care of small bugs in the operating system. You may also need to hard reset your device if the screen goes black or freezes. What to do before resetting your Android Reset will require a minimum battery level of 25%. Backup all your phones data. This will reset the device to the factory default state and it will clear out the memory buffers and reset the phone and application data. When you try to start up your device after completing a factory reset, you are required to log in to the original Google Account in the initial setup. If you have encrypted the microSD card, you must decrypt it before resetting the phone. Otherwise, your phone will not be able to read the data on the card. Factory resetting of the device can be done in two ways, i.e. the Factory Reset & Hard Reset. Reset Screen Lock Oppo A5 Open Find My Device and then log in with your Google Account and password. Select the Oppo A5 from the top left hand corner of the menu. Choose the Erase option from the action menu. Select Erase Device to confirm. Enter your Google Account password to reset the Oppo A5. If your Oppo A5 (2020) smartphone is running very slowly, hanging, you want to bypass the screen lock, or you have a full memory and want to erase everything, or you want to sell or give it away and want to ensure that nobody can access your files and passwords, you can do a factory reset to restore it to its original state like the first day. In the following steps we explain how to format the Oppo A5 (2020) to erase all your information and make it totally clean as it came out of the store. Before doing a factory reset, we recommend deleting all the accounts on the device, specifically it is useful to unlink the Google account if you are going to sell, donate, or give away your A5 (2020). This will avoid problems for the new user, as some newer devices include a functionality called FRP (Factory Reset Protection) that requires the same Google account or PIN code with which the Oppo A5 (2020) was initially configured when factory resetting a device. Keep in mind that a reset or return to the factory state on a mobile/cell phone deletes all its content, so make a backup of your data before doing it if you don't want to lose everything. In case you do not want to erase the data from the device, you can try to restart the Oppo A5 (2020).. There are two ways to do a reset on an Oppo A5 (2020) one through the mobile options and another more complete from the recovery mode. If you want to make a reset using the device options to return to the factory state an Oppo A5 (2020) you have to follow these simple steps: Estimated time: 5 minutes. 1- First step: To access the settings menu on your Oppo CPH1931, CPH1959, CPH1933, CPH1935, CPH1943, look for the icon that resembles a cogwheel. Click or tap on it to open the settings menu. 2- Second step: Scroll down the Oppo A5 (2020) settings to the bottom where you will see the section called System, click or tap to continue. 3- Third step: Click on Reset options from this section it will allow us to restore network options, applications or reset the Oppo A5 (2020) completely. 4- Fourth step: Click on the last option called Erase all data (factory reset) or simply Factory data reset. 5- Fifth step: A first confirmation message will appear reminding you that all your data will be deleted from this device, the data you have uploaded to Google, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram or backup copies that you have in the cloud, such as Google Drive, Dropbox or One Drive, will not be deleted. The Google accounts linked to this Oppo A5 (2020) will also be displayed. IMPORTANT: after formatting and rebooting, the device will ask you to enter the password of the main Google account so you must know it or have it written down before doing a restore factory. Press Erase all data. 6- Sixth step: A second confirmation message will appear indicating that all information stored on the Oppo A5 (2020) and all downloaded applications will be erased and reminding that this action cannot be undone. If you agree, click on Erase all data. 7- Seventh step: If necessary, draw the screen unlock pattern or enter the screen unlock password or PIN to continue. 8- Eighth step: Your device A5 (2020) from Oppo it will restart and take several minutes to start while restoring the device to its factory state and optimizing the applications pre-installed in the operative system Android 9.0 (Pie); ColorOS 6.0. If you cannot turn on the Oppo A5 (2020) and therefore you cannot perform the factory restore from the device settings, this method does not work for you and you should consult the tutorial to hard reset A5 (2020).
