
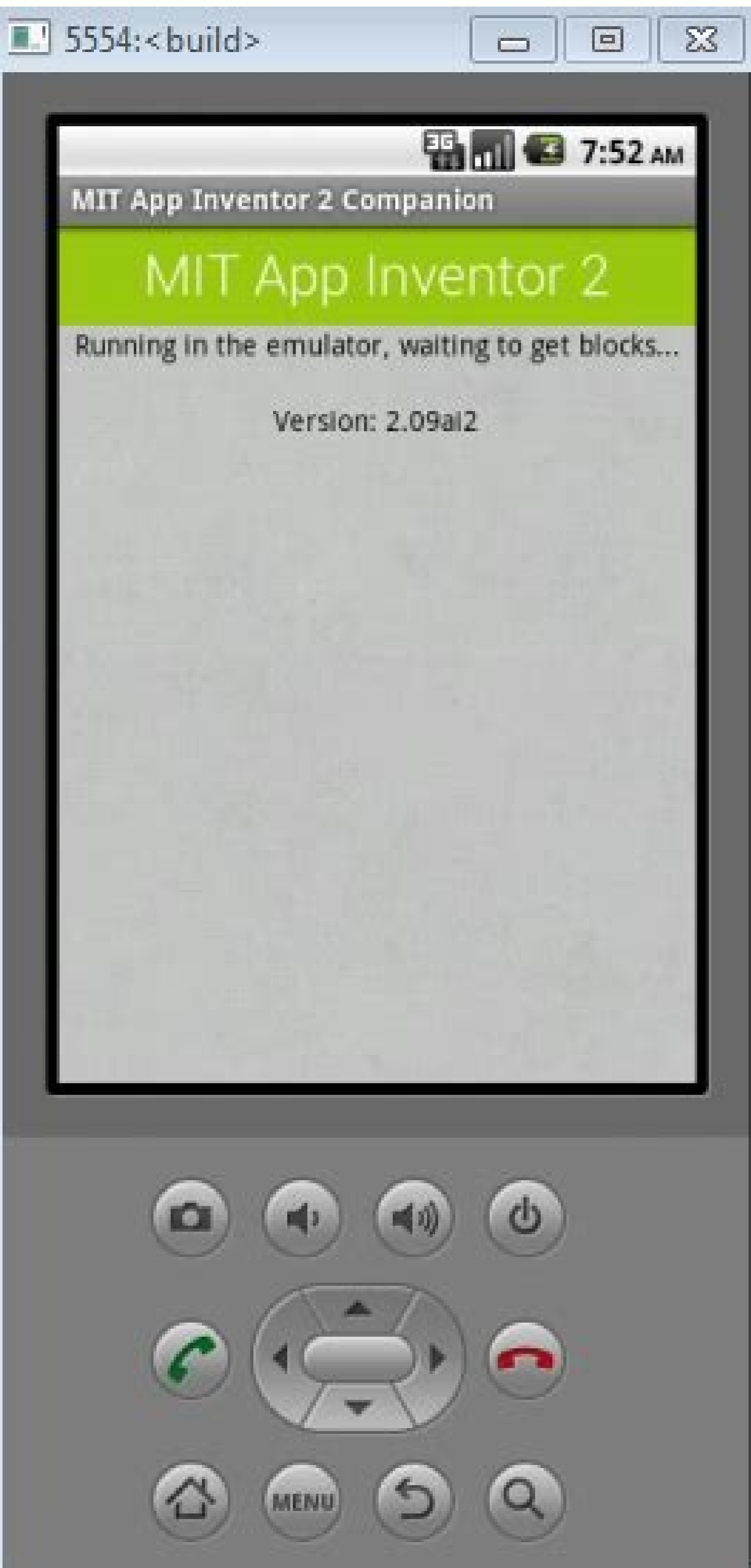


App not found sd card

This morning I listened to my Samsung Galaxy S7 Edge, but I presented all the programs on the SD card and in the folder, trying to start the message "not found". These programs also have the Gray SD card icon. The transmission of the Root magazine program allows you to launch the program. However, the transfer of the program to internal memory. Removing the program and re-installation will not help. You can also use system cache. Is there a correction? The output is about moving all programs from the folders, but this means that I can't organize them. We'll work with solutions, so you can help me. This morning I restarted my Samsung Galaxy S7 Edge after restarting the entire SD card apps, and when trying to run, the "app not found" message is displayed in the folder. These apps are marked with a gray SD card icon. When moving the app to the root tank, the program can operate. However, moving the app to internal memory is not. The application uninstall and reinstall do not help. There is also no cleaning system. Need to be repaired? The solution is to move all apps from folders, but that means I can't edit them either. Little Hi Boys in front of them are very few, they are just honest. Honestly, it's a fair, it's just them, it's a fair, can you help? I use the compact Sony Xperia Z3, recently updated to Android 5.0.2 with an update that adds Sony support to app moving to SD card. I went freely and moved everything I could, to SD and everything was doing well. The missing apps are not displayed in the Play Store settings or recently installed apps. The only things ever for app installation are damaged acronyms and the fact that I saw their files on the SD map when I browse. I have tried to reboot, balance, pull out and remove the SD card without success. However, by reinstalling some applications, they were prevented. After reinstalling, I move them to the SD card and they work well and break again. However, I still have a lot of damaged apps and reinstallation will require forever. It seems that the SD card could be installed elsewhere and broke all connections? Possible? After an error occurs, save all the files on the card (on a computer, in the cloud, in a place of choice), form the card and reinstall all the apps (from the Play Store). So fix it on your computer (you can use the backup and recovery of the app) if you need (or you can install older fuses "restoring" Google Maps, which makes you more useless). Then move them on paper. Move an app onNo. It moves parts of the program to different places on the map and leaves links to these areas in internal memory. (Android is looking for apps in the inner storage, whether they were "transferred" or not.) If you move several pieces, the Android program Dates is not where they claim. Currently, even someone with many years of hacking experience would not try to "solve" the problem, he will instead install programs. (I have retired after more than 40 years of system development - corporate piracy to buy their products - and if someone offered me to work in such a way as to find and re-connected some of the parts on the application card - he will have to offer me. So much money to make money I would even consider that I knew it was not smart enough to get this type of money, this type of backup copies need another.) The right way to get more space in the storage facility than you have, is rooted. Phone (requires a change that can only be made by roots) and run a program such as external 2 internal SD (or learned Linux) to attach the card as SD0 and internal storage as SD1 (unlike what passes usually). After that, Android is still looking for SD0 apps, searching card, downloading card, installing apps, etc. The life expectancy of the card is lower than in the phone's memory (for constant writing). (In addition, SD cards are expected to be written occasionally and read a lot), but usually last as long as you plan to have a phone or longer. However, no storage facility is infallible, so make sure everything you don't want to lose is preserved. ) Everything. I hope this can help you.
