Type wsim bios get serialnumber in prompt window and press enter Open power user menu on Start icon. Select "Terminal" option. Type or copy paste command: wsim bios get serialnumber into prompt window and press enter. You will see your device's serial number.The serial number might be printed on laptop back or case, especially for Apple. However, it may also be pasted as barcode sticker with text too small to read without a magnifying glass.Take a picture of the barcode using your phone and zoom to find the serial number. Alternatively, scan the barcode using your mobile camera.If you can't see the sticker, try other methods from this article to find your device's serial number.BIOS or UEFI is firmware that helps boot system. You can access it by pressing F2 key during startup. This method may vary depending on manufacturer.Income BIOS/UEFI settings and search for serial number in main screen. In Huawei MateBook, it shows like below image.BIOS/UEFI provides universal way to find device serial number. Most laptops come with custom app for driver management and installation. If you have no such app, use other methods from this article. Looking for laptop serial number Huawei PC Manager app should be checked first but if not found go to Windows settings then check installed apps section and search Huawei PC Manager app which is located under quick services section or in microsoft account devices menu. To find your laptop's serial number, follow these steps: - Restart your computer and press BIOS keys such as F2 or Del during boot-up. - Look for System Information or Product Information to locate the serial number. - Alternatively, check the original packaging, receipt, or online account of your manufacturer if you are registered. - On Dell laptops, the serial number is located on a tag under the computer. - It contains numbers and letters, usually a five- to seven-character code. - Verify it by checking for "service tag" on the label.
