With the Techniques, color pencils can function easily for almost any age level with impressive results. Read to seven the great color of color pencils that your students will love. 1. Increasing the light colored layers using any type of brand brand until all paper is covered and the surface comes up waxy and smooth. 2. Scraping Use an X-Act knife on a polished surface to pluck pigment areas. This works well to capture fine details such as individual hair, or as a means of removing color to re-work a problematic area. 3. Directional lines draw lightly in a direction in fast, even blows. Colors of layer to add complexity and depth. This is an excellent temporal for any object with a distinct linear quality such as fabric, grass or draped hair. 4. Sculpt moves the pencils into circular marks, layer as you go. This technique is very versatile, working well to create a distinct texture or smooth and mixed areas. 5. CrossHatching sets a layer of directional lines and pass the same area with lines in the opposite direction. This is another great technique to create texture. 6. The "baby leo or friction alcohol add a small amount of baby oil or rubbing alcohol to a cotton ball and rub the areas you want to mix. The trick to do this work is to make sure to use only a bit of the blender on the ball of cotton. For small areas, try a Q-tip instead. 7. Watercolor wash the tape your paper to your work surface to avoid curling. Then cover large areas with a light watercolor washing. After your paper is totally dry, layer color pencil on the background color for impressive results in less time. There are so many different effects you can create. Do not be afraid to try other combinations of mixed media too. For example, a white gel pen or white acríple paint can be a great way to add highlights to the completed work. The possibilities are really endless, then make sure you encourage the experiment! You can learn from the artistic ideas of others and develop your own way to see the world. So you can recreate your visions in your colored pencils! Start with a doodle. The blank white paper page can be intimidating. To begin, use any color of your color pencils to make a giant scribble in the center of the page. The page is not more blank. Does not it look better? Now, give a good look at the scribble on the page. What resembles? A stream? The edge of a plot sheet? A street from Vila Pie? The crooked leg of the leg of a dog? Working around the scribble on the page, try to sketch in more detail. If you are still totally perplexed, start drawing other lines and try to create a fascinating and hypnotic pattern on the page using so many color pencils that you can. Look at something common on a common path. Take a moment and actually examine something common and try to create a new way to "seeing" that object. For example, look at a flower and think of a new way to sketch the flower. Maybe you should throw the flower on the floor and step on it, or you can zoom in on the flower and sketch a traditionally neglected part of the flower. Maybe the stamens coated by the powder need your focus. Maybe you want to represent drops of dew on the leaves or beads. Look around your house and discover something for "verse" differently. Maybe they are the folds of velvet in their curtain. Maybe you want to make a close-up of the fiber patterns in your scarf. Recreate the grain pattern on the wood in your kitchen cabin. Maybe you take an object and go back down or deserve. Unexpected amnegulum. Start thinking not traditionally and portray something unexpected. 4. Pull something out of a hat. When you are not entirely feeling the inspiration, sometimes forcing yourself to look and sketching anything can have your creative juices flowing. Place eight or ten large categories in paper mines and draw one random. So, we can find an object that fits in this category and sketched for 15 or 20 minutes. Chances are that we just started in a piece will help you find other things that are interesting. A dark and grumpy landscape can invoke sadness as much as the representation of a person's face. 5. Make several drawings of different versions of the same thing.think of a random object that you may like to draw. Do not make it very complicated. You just want a single simple object. Then divide your drawing paper into four sections. Alternatively, if you like "big", you may want to use four separate drawing paper sheets. Now think of four different ways to portray this object in a drawing. For example, if you thought of a log, you could draw a landscape that owns Log.Next cabin, you could sketch a drawing of a group of boy boy scouts Maybe you will increase the zoom in the log and draw a detailed sketch of the bark pattern in the log, including the moss that is found on it,perhaps you will draw a fireplace with a mantle of marble and a large crackling trunk In an inception.
