During the Middle Ages, the area of present-day Ghana was home to a number of powerful kingdoms such as the Ashanti Empire and the Kingdom of Dagbon. The first Europeans to come into contact with the local population were the Portuguese who came to West Africa in the 15th century. They established a colony called the Portuguese Gold Coast which focused on gold mining and trade. Eventually, Dutch, Swedish, Danish and German traders joined the Portuguese and established their colonies in the Gold Coast region. Everyone wanted to seize power over the region because of the oil, natural gas and gold deposits. The British Empire was attracted to the Gold Coast in the early 19th century. His attempts to establish control of the coast led to a series of wars with the Ashanti Empire, which wanted the territory for itself. The tribes who inhabited the coast sided with the British against the Ashanti raids. In all, there were five Anglo-Ashanti wars. After the final war, known as the Golden Stool War, the British founded a colony that encompassed the entire territory of the Gold Coast. In addition to gold, the British exploited and exported other goods including cocoa, wheat, pepper, timber, ivory, diamonds and metallic minerals. They put a lot of effort into developing the colony's transport infrastructure and building schools and hospitals. The Second World War significantly weakened the colonial powers, initiating the process of decolonization, as the indigenous population of many colonies demanded more autonomy. In 1947, J. B. Danquah founded the United Gold Coast Convention (UGCC), a political party that sought Ghana's independence from Britain. The leaders of Ebenezer Ako-Adjei, Edward Akufo-Addo, J. B. Danquah, Kwame Nkrumah, Emmanuel Obetsebi-Lampety and William Ofori Atta are referred to as the Big Six and considered the founding fathers of Ghana. Four years later, legislative elections were held for the first time on the Gold Coast. It was the first election by universal suffrage in Africa. It was won by the People's Convention Party led by Kwame Nkrumah, who had split from UGCC. He became Prime Minister of the Gold Coast in 1952. On August 3, 1956, the newly elected Legislative Assembly voted for the independence of the Gold Coast as Ghana, effective March 6, 1957. The country's Independence Anniversary is now celebrated as Ghana's National Day. Ghana Independence Day is celebrated nationwide with a number of festivities, including speeches, concerts, festivals, street parties, and more. The highlight of the party is a large parade taking place in Black Star Square, also known as Independence Square, in the nation's capital of Accra. [2] The first Prime Minister of Ghana, Kwame Nkrumah served as Head of Government from 1957 to 1960. [3] On March 6, 1957, Kwame Nkrumah told the people of Ghana about their freedom, adding that "the African people are able to run their own affairs and Ghana our beloved country is free forever." [4] Ghana was the first country in sub-Saharan Africa to achieve its independence from European colonial rule. [5] Many Ghanaians who had the opportunity to lead the country as presidents commemorated Ghana's Independence Day and declared the day a public holiday for celebration. [8] Many presidents from other African and European countries have been invited to Ghana to participate in the celebration either as guest speakers or guests invited by the reign of former President Kwame Nkrumah until now.
