Michael Norman Manley, ON, OM (born December 10, 1924 in the parish of Saint Andrew, Jamaica; He was Prime Minister of Jamaica from 1972 to 1980 and from 1989 to 1992. During its first term, Jamaica made a brief transition to a pro-Soviet foreign policy. Life Michael Manley came from one of the most influential families in Jamaica. His father Norman Washington Manley was Chief Minister, his cousin Hugh Shearer was Prime Minister, and his wife Edna Manley was a well-known artist and activist. He was also related to former Prime Minister Alexander Bustamante. Manley's party, the National People's Party (PNP), won significantly the 1972 parliamentary election and represented the new Prime Minister's strongest group. Manley has fought to improve the living conditions of the poor. It has enacted numerous social laws, for the financing of which it has nationalized several companies, notably banks, bauxite mining companies and large plantations.[1] Other companies have acquired public ownership through acquisitions. During his tenure, democratic structures remained intact and the free market economy was able to continue to exist, albeit with some limitations. For this reason, the new state order cannot be called socialist, but has been perceived as such in part abroad. Manley's close friendship with Fidel Castro and Jamaica's close diplomatic relations with Cuba have also contributed to this. Despite intensive negotiations, relations with the International Monetary Fund have been cut off and Jamaica has lost loans deemed safe. The lack of funds from international sources and the increasing use of the "Jamaica Way" in drug trafficking have increased the crime rate. In 1976 the state of emergency was prolonged; in the same year an attempted coup against the government was discovered before it could be carried out. Bands, each close to one of the two major parties, fought street battles for supremacy in some parts of the city, particularly Kingston. Rising violence and widespread poverty caused the NPP to lose the 1980 elections. However, Manley was able to choose the 1989 election once again. This term has been more serene than previous ones and has for the most part given up new social reforms. In March 1992, he retired for health reasons.[2] Percival J. Patterson became his successor. Franklyn was presented with the Keys of the city of Miramar, Florida on February 23, 2005, which was also declared Delo Franklyn Dayä for the contribution of him to Jamaican diaspora and his support for foreign citizens. He is a trained teacher, a former director of the National Service of Jamaica Youth and was the head of a former Prime Minister of Jamaica. During his years at High School, College and University, Mr. Franklyn was elected president of a series of student and young organizations at national level. The only Jamaican to have been the President of the National Council of Secondary Students (NSSC) and Jamaica Union of Tertiary Students (JUTS), and even the only Jamaican to have been elected president of the Gilda of the Graduates at both Campus of the university of West Indies in Mona and Cave Hill, respectively. He received his secondary education at Kingston College and his tertiary training at Mico Teachers College (now Mico University College), the university of West Indies and Norman Manley Law School. He is president of the Michael Manley Foundation and the Asafa Powell Foundation. The president of the Committee has planned the coming celebrations for Jamaica athletes after the 2004 Olympic Games. In 2006 and Mr. Franklyn represented Jamaica in the subcommittee of the Prime Minister of Carrocom on Cricket planning and preparation of the World Cup of Cricket 2007. In 1999 he was appointed Justice of Peace and in 2000, he was one of the distinct graduates who received the Millennium Award from Mico MicoCollege.
